The Rotary Club of Peterborough helped found Five Counties over 45 years ago when the need for a children's treatment centre in our local communities became clear. Year after year, Rotary Peterborough continues to hold fundraisers and support Five Counties in multiple ways. In 2021, Rotary Peterborough revived their golf tournament and presented Five Counties with a generous donation of \$3,000.
