## PILOT WORKSHOP

Five Counties is partnering with Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital to provide an opportunity to engage in a ground-breaking robotic LEGO experience. Participants will work hands on with robotic LEGO through interactive building activities and lessons.

This pilot workshop will be led by Holland Bloorview staff and Five Counties Recreation Therapists, in a group environment.

### PROGRAM GOALS:

- Opportunity to explore new leisure interests through science, technology, engineering, and/or math (STEM)
- Practice and develop decision making and problem-solving skills
- Opportunity to practice following written, pictured, and verbal directions/instructions
- Practice socialization skills in a group setting

### PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Children aged 7 years and older involved with Therapeutic Recreation Services at Five Counties Children's Centre
- Children must be interested in participating in the selected robotics program as well as be motivated to work towards a selected goal throughout the session
- Children must be able to participate in a structured two-hour group program safely and successfully
- Children must be able to follow 1-2 step directions and simple rules
