Spotlight: Special Olympics Winter Programs

Active Start: (ages 2-6): Tues, 6:15-6:45 pm FUNdamentals: (ages 7-12): Thurs, 7-7:45 pm



Children of all abilities take part, and they all benefit! Special Olympics Young Athletes, Active Start, is a sport and play program for children with intellectual disabilities, ages 2-6. Active Start introduces basic sport skills, like balance, running, kicking, throwing and striking. Active Start offers families, caregivers and community members the chance to share the joy of sports with all children. This is a 'parented' program where caregivers assist the athlete in developing essential skills by following the coach's directions/instructions, model skills and otherwise participate fully in activities alongside the athlete. Physical activity is essential for healthy development.



Kawartha Gymnastics







Recreation Funding/Grants

City of Peterborough: Recreation Fee Subsidy Program

- Assists low-income families and families receiving social assistance who live in Peterborough to
 offset registration costs for recreational programs offered by the City or other organizations within
 the City of Peterborough.
- Funds available, but not limited to: sports activities, aquatic programs and camps for dependent children 18 years and under.
- Apply for multiple programs at once, for one or more participants. The maximum subsidy per child is \$100 (or \$200 per year depending on the low-income cut off per household).

KidSport Canada

- Provides grants to kids from families facing financial barriers so they can participate in registered sport programs and experience the lifelong benefits of a season of sport.
- Grants of up to \$250/eligible kid, per year (Jan. 1-Dec. 31) towards sport registration fees.
