- Rock & Roll Adaptive Gymnastics (for kids walking to 7 years) Tuesdays, April 30-June 18, 8-weeks, \$90/child
 This program in partnership with Five Counties Children's Center is customized for kids 7 years and under with exceptional needs. Participate in a family-oriented gymnastics program in which caregivers take part. Make friends as you work on




motor skills, balance, strength, flexibility, climbing and more all in a safe, supportive atmosphere.

- Special Olympics Rhythmic Gymnastics (for all ages) May and June
 This new program in partnership with Special Olympics Peterborough follows the Rhythmic
 Gymnastics program outline directed from Special Olympics. Rhythmic gymnastics is a sport that
 combines elements of ballet, gymnastics, dance, and apparatus manipulation. Individuals or teams
 of competitors (from 2 to 6 people) manipulate one or two pieces of apparatus: rope, clubs, hoop,
 ball, ribbon and Free (no apparatus, so called "floor routine"). This spring session runs for 6 weeks
 in May and June. Athletes who are registered members with Special Olympics will not need to pay
 the \$40 Gymnastics Ontario insurance fee. Athletes who participate are not required to compete.
- Adaptive Drop-In (for all ages), Wednesdays and Fridays (Noon to 2 pm), \$15/class
 This adaptive drop-in is for individuals of all ages with sensory needs. This unstructured drop-in lets
 participants explore the facility! Swing on the bars, balance on the beams, jump on the trampolines
 and more! Support workers attend for free. Annual Gymnastics Ontario insurance fee is due upon
 first visit.



- For kids/youth of all ages (those 3 yrs and under must have parent/guardian present with them at all times in gym)



Recreation Funding/Grants

City of Peterborough: Recreation Fee Subsidy Program

- Assists low-income families and families receiving social assistance who live in Peterborough to
 offset registration costs for recreational programs offered by the City or other organizations within
 the City of Peterborough.
- Funds available, but not limited to: sports activities, aquatic programs and camps for dependent children 18 years and under.
- Apply for multiple programs at once, for one or more participants. The maximum subsidy per child is \$100 (or \$200 per year depending on the low-income cut off per household).

KidSport Canada

- Provides grants to kids from families facing financial barriers so they can participate in registered sport programs and experience the lifelong benefits of a season of sport.
- Grants of up to \$250/eligible kid, per year (Jan. 1-Dec. 31) towards sport registration fees.
