



Occupational Therapy- Preschoolers By Age 2

Typical Fine Motor and Daily Activity Development

- Grasps small object between thumb and fingers
- Able to string large beads
- Able to bring spoon/fork to mouth with little spillage
- Able to drink from an open cup
- Helps with undressing
- Plays appropriately with toys geared to child's age
- Identifies 6 body parts
- Matches 3 colours
- Turns puzzle piece to place in puzzle or shape sorter



When to Call

- Has significant difficulty picking up and grasping small objects
- Fatigues or gives up easily
- Explores objects with mouth most of the time
- Frequently loses balance in sitting when using hands
- Needs physical help to eat and drink
- Has significant difficulty playing with toys geared for his/her age
- Has difficulty reaching across own body
