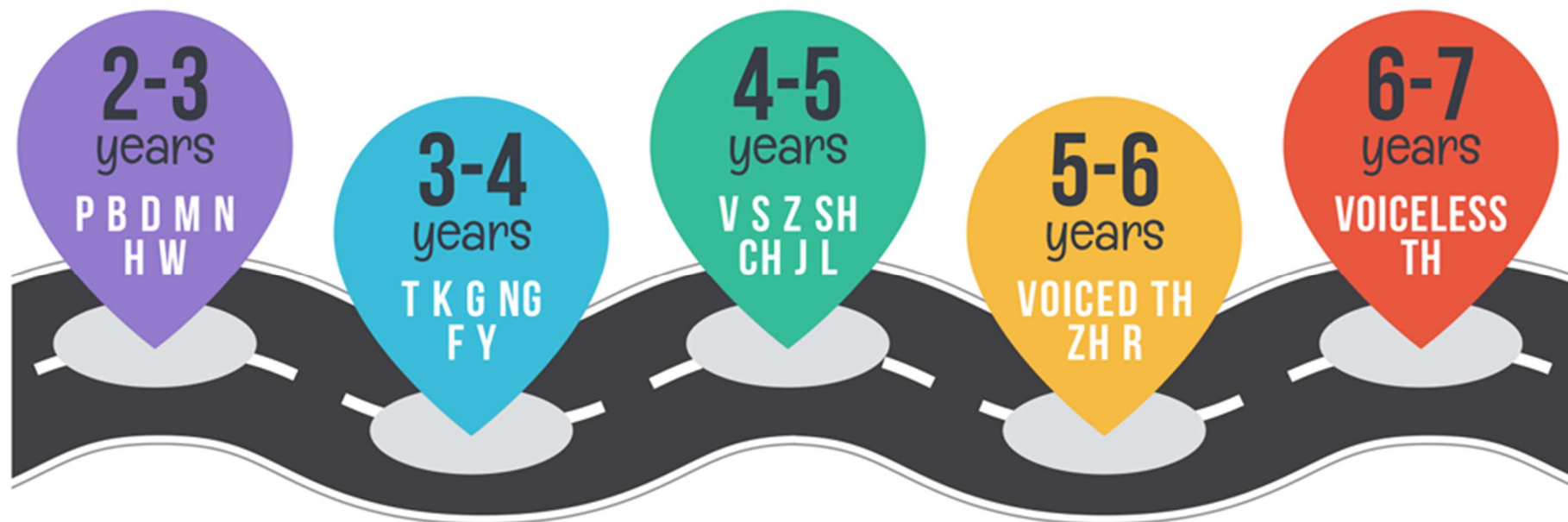


SPEECH SOUND Development



Voiced TH is the "buzzy" TH sound (as in "they," "weather," and "smooth.")
Voiceless TH is the "quiet" TH sound (as in "think," "python," and "math.")
